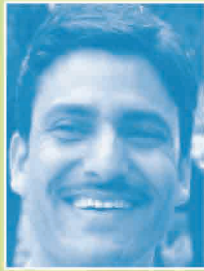


This book for early readers tells the story of a curious child who shares his house with many animals — from a cow in his shed to a bird on his ceiling.
