can change the color of your feet!





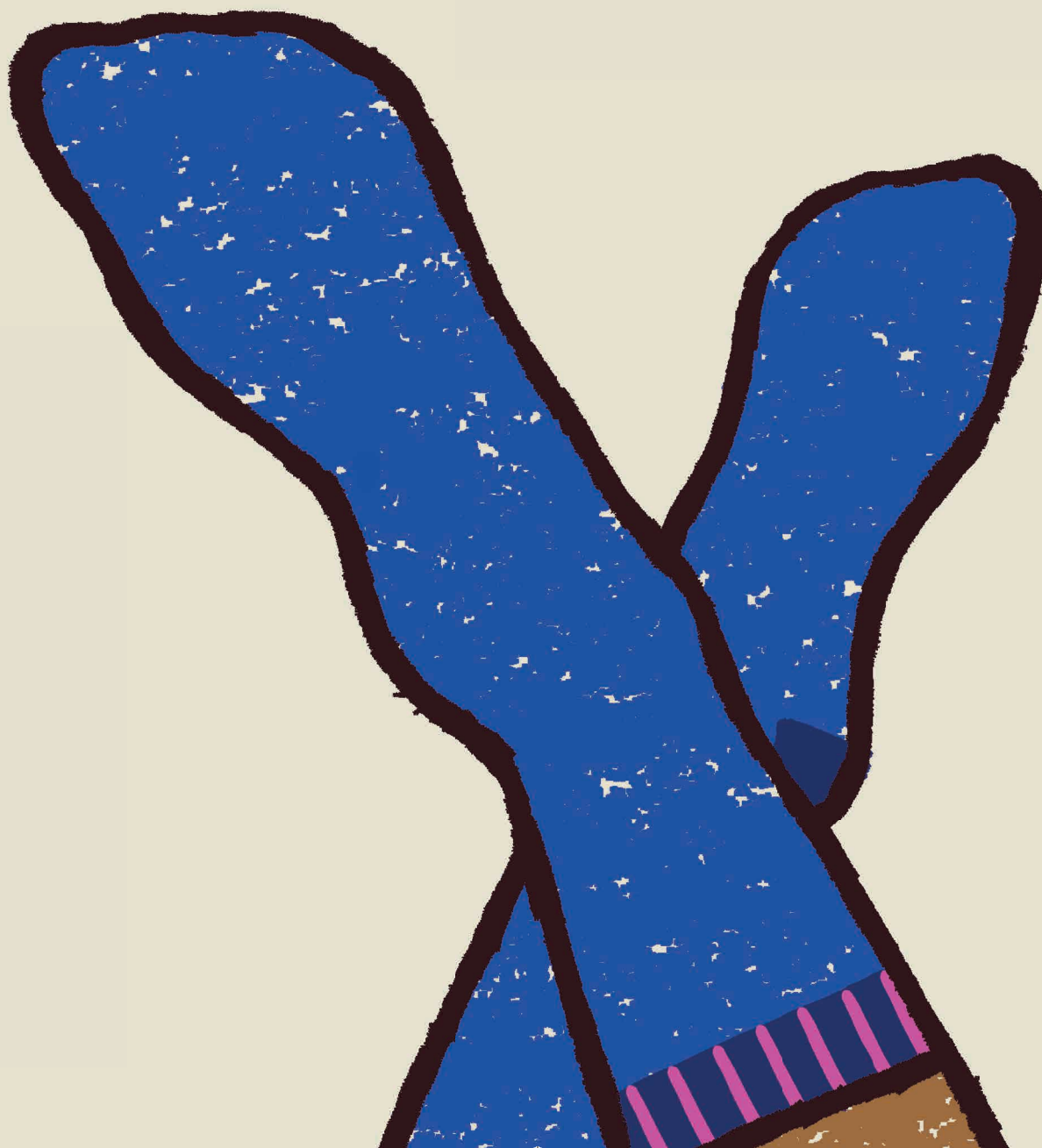


If you want red feet, wear red socks.

She puts colorful socks on her cup, her bat, and her ball. "Ma, look!" Anu says. "I made three new, colorful friends!"





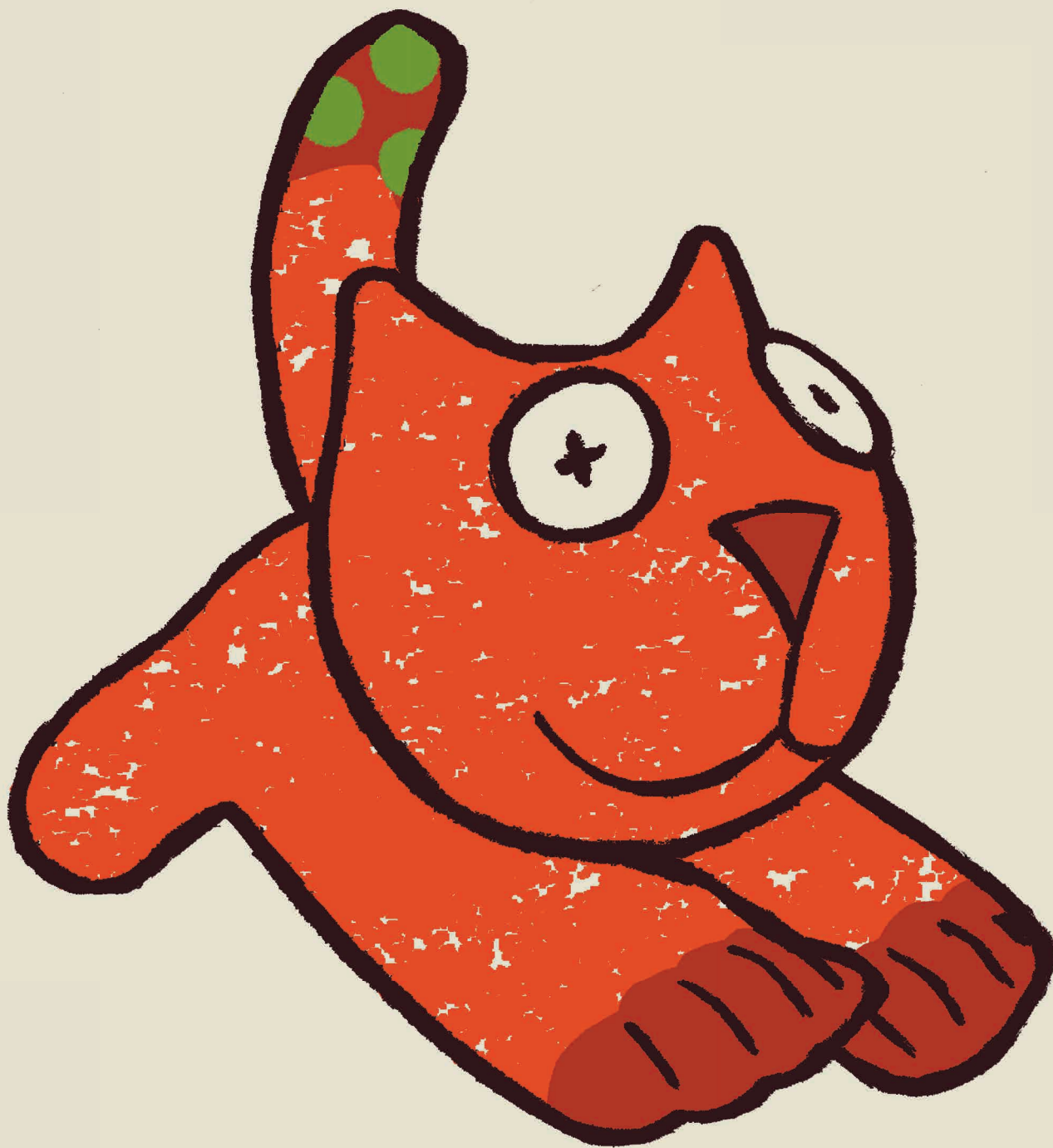




The next day, Anu gets a surprise. One of her socks has turned into an elephant!
