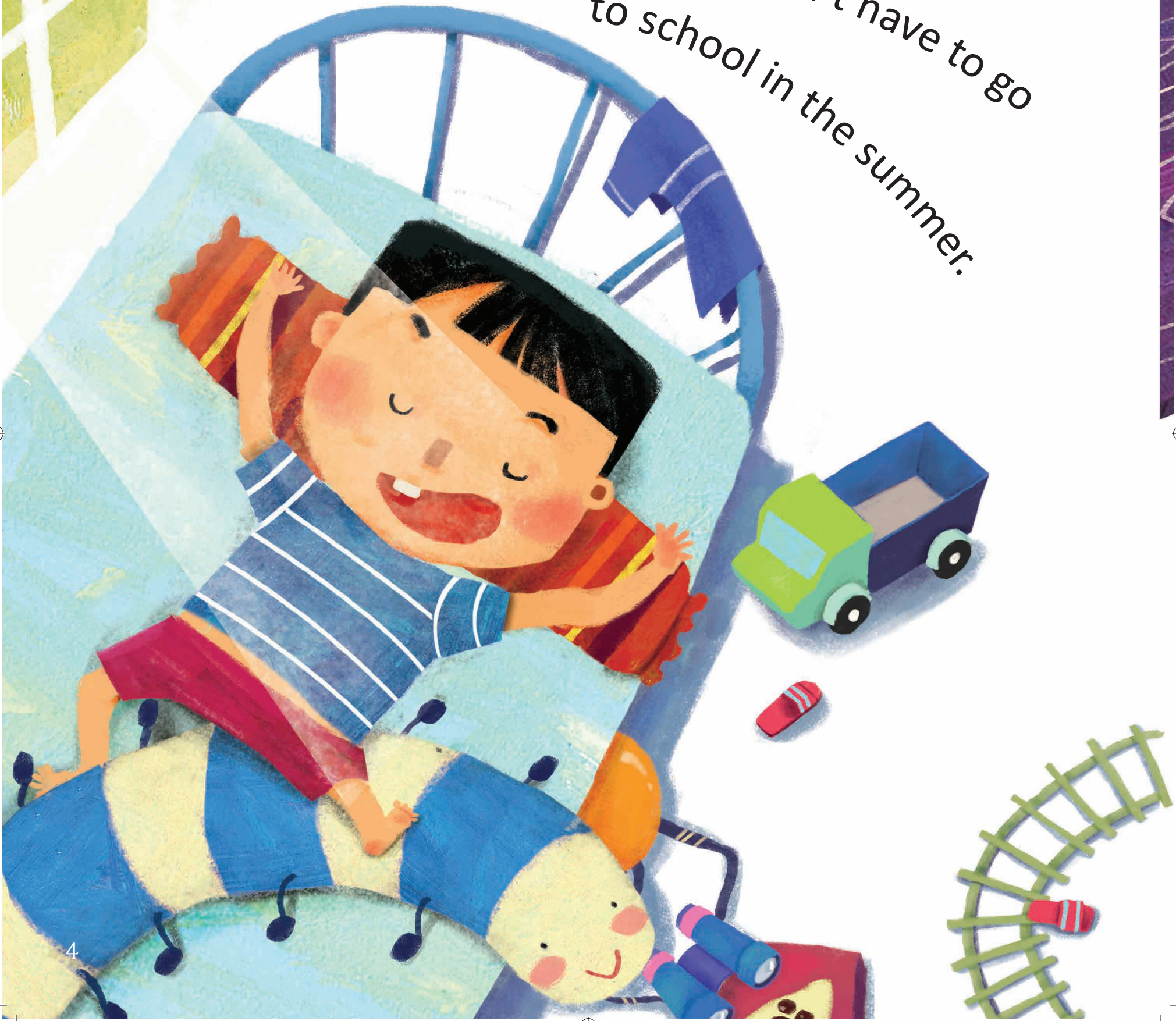

vacation and Unnie wants to play.

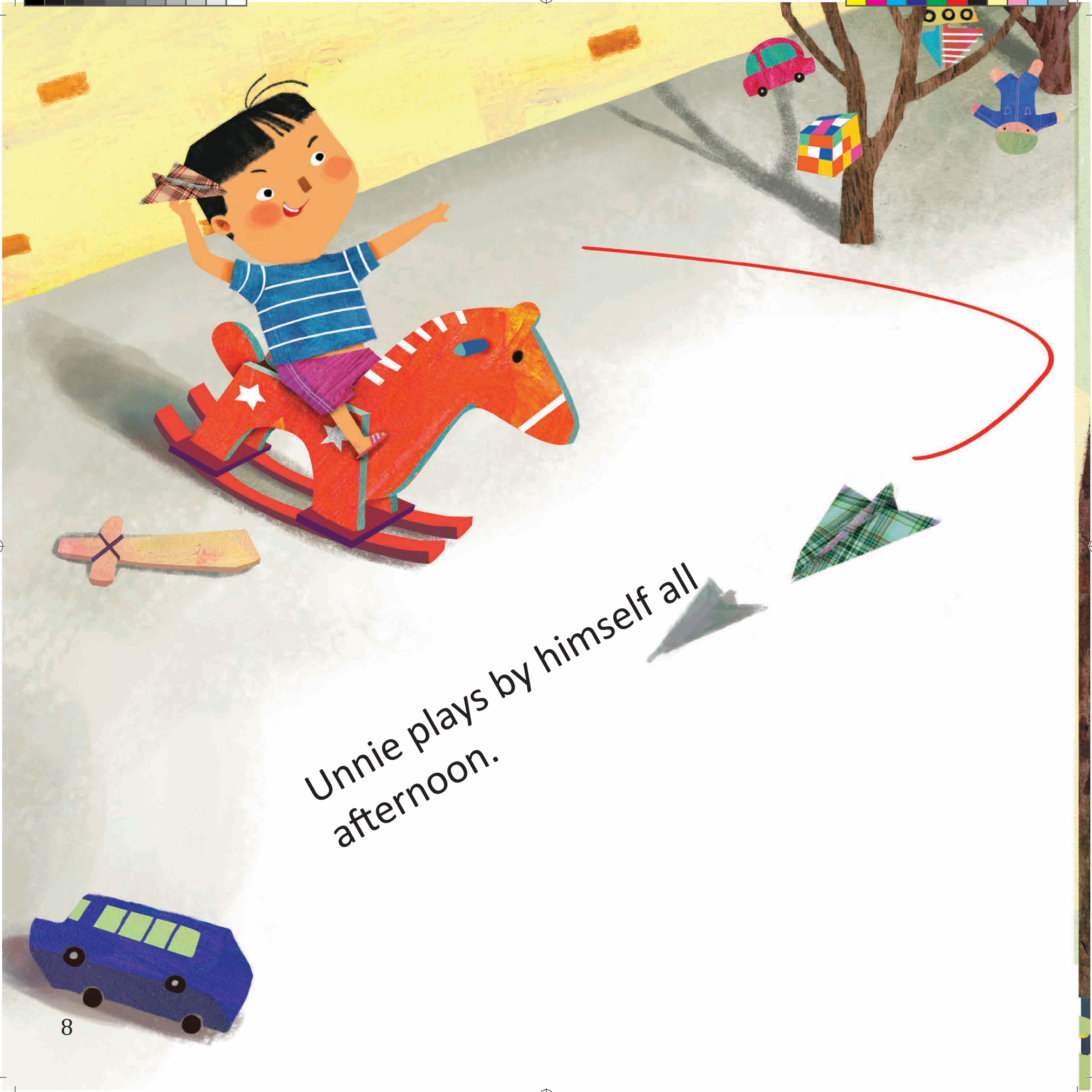





"I am busy reading a book,

The sun is about to set and Unnie is getting tired of playing alone.

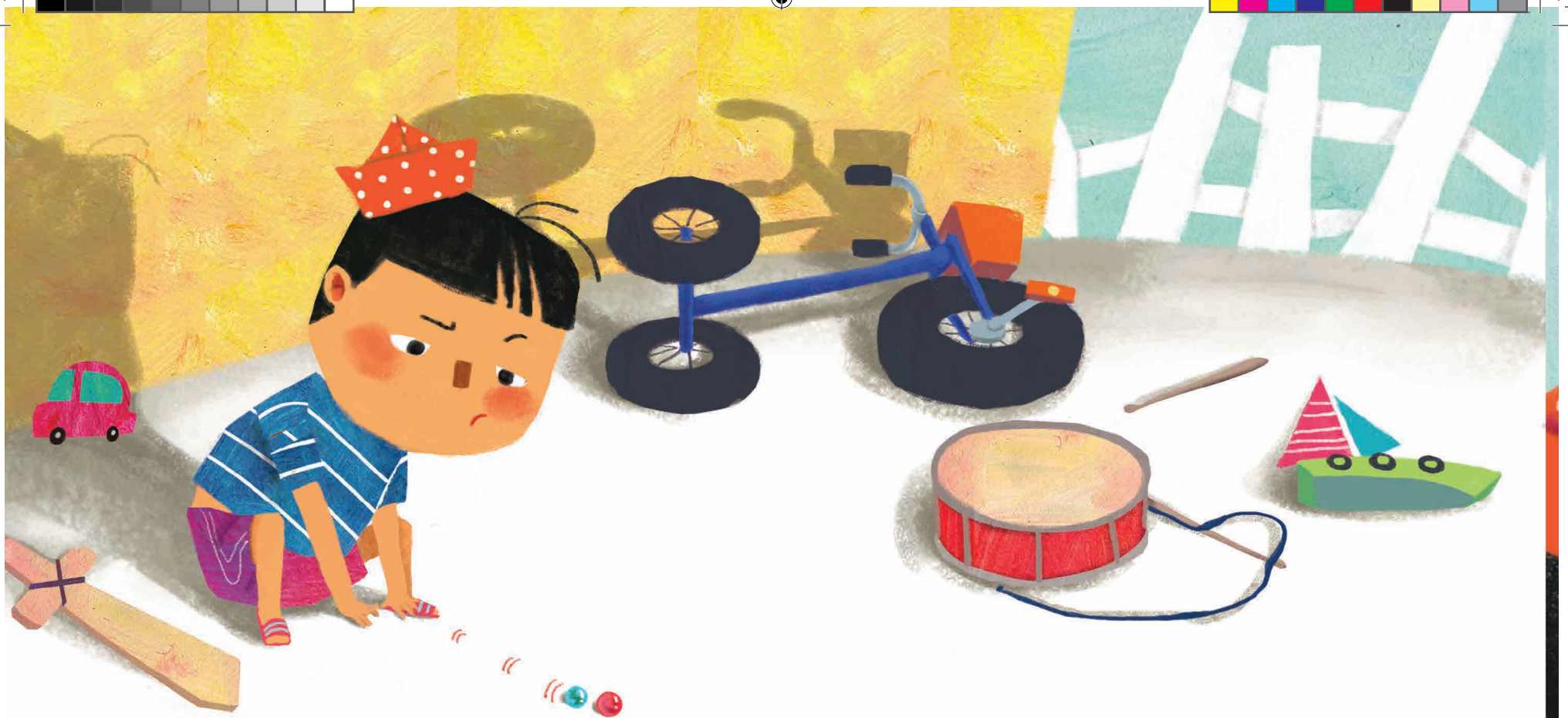
"Come to my house, Innies! I have so many toys!" he says.

UNNIE!"



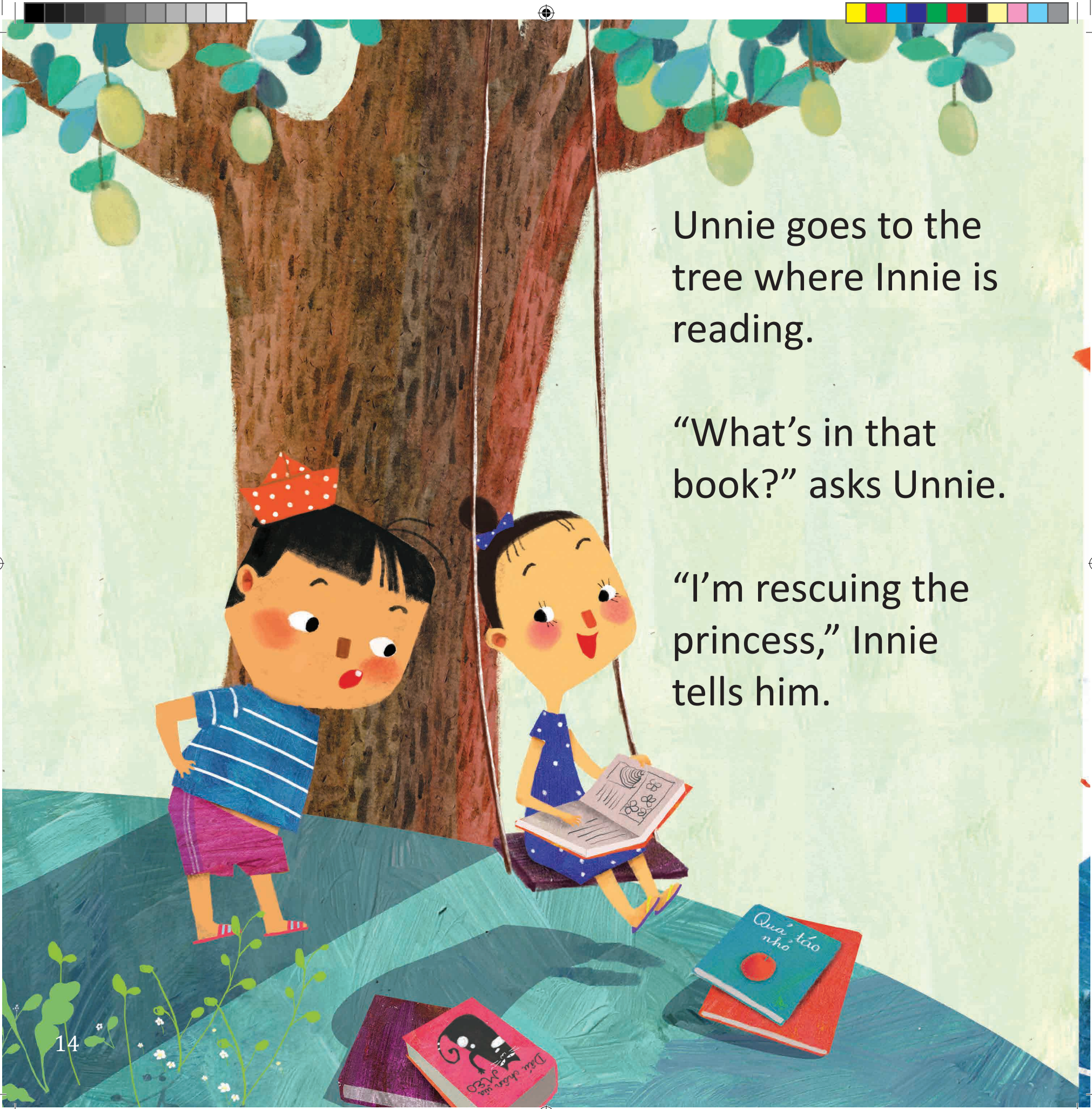


Unnie is frustrated.

Unnie goes to the tree where Innie is reading.

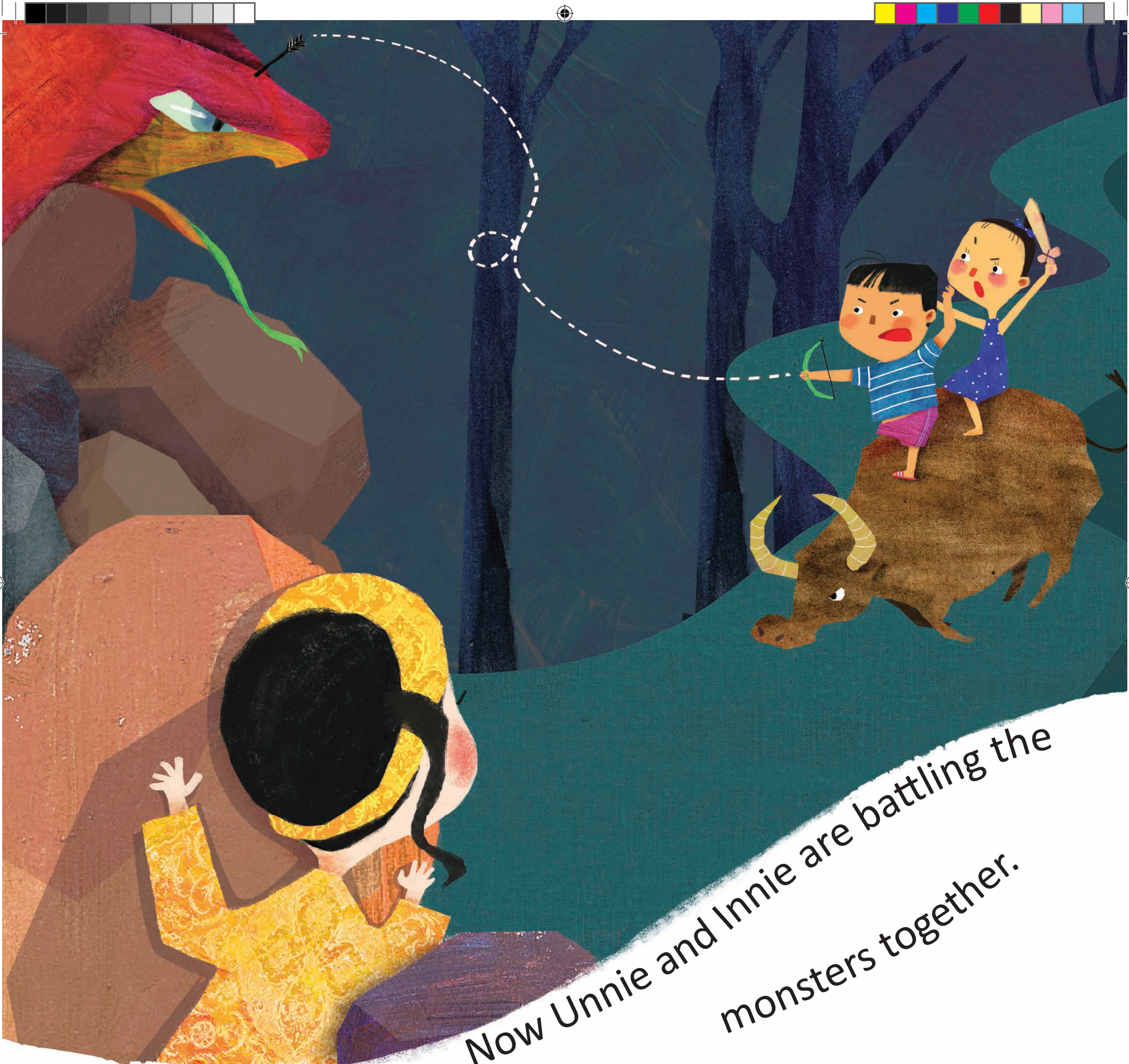
“What’s in that book?” asks Unnie.
